Numbers for 18 September 2007

In the last 6+ weeks, we mourn the deaths of **Corporal Terrence Allen** of Pennsauken, killed 15 September 2007, (this is the second tragic death of a citizen from Pennsauken: **Sergeant Michael Egan** was killed two years ago on 19 September 2005); **Lance Corporal Jon Hicks, Jr.**, of Atco killed 10 September 2007; **Staff Sergeant Jason Butkus** of **West Milford**, killed 30 August 2007, and **Specialist Kareem Khan** of Manahawkin, killed 6 August 2007. This is 66 New Jersey people too many.

Do you believe President Bush's actions justify impeachment? **Voting Whether Bush Should Be Impeached:** 89% — 502,800 people — vote FOR IMPEACHMENT out of 564,944 votes cast as of 11:00 a.m. New Jersey time, September 18th, 2007. Only 9.2% — just 51,974 people — say Bush should not be impeached, with the rest unsure. 95% of the American people do not trust Bush to end the Iraq war successfully.
